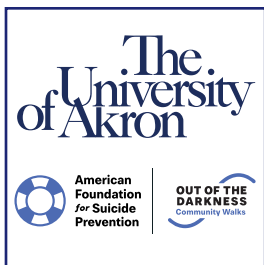

'Out of the Darkness' Campus Walk Program – Sunday, April 28, 2019

The University of Akron (UA) Out of the Darkness Campus Walk is a local support and fundraising walk that helps the American Foundation for Suicide Prevention (AFSP) engage youth and young adults in the fight to prevent suicide. UA event founder Scott Palasik, an associate professor at the School of Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology, has put an increased effort on trying to get veterans involved in the walk in some way. Those walking in silver represent the loss of a military veteran or active duty family member or loved one to suicide.
