1. Acknowledgment of Risk

The Owner understands that working with animals, including dogs, involves inherent risks. These risks may include, but are not limited to, bites, scratches, property damage, or injury to persons or other animals and any unforeseen circumstances.

2. Assumption of Responsibility

The Owner agrees to assume full responsibility for any damages or injuries caused by their dog during training sessions, whether on or off the training premises.

3. Release and Waiver

The Owner hereby releases, waives, and discharges the SCVSC and CC from any and all liability, claims, demands, or causes of action arising out of or related to any injury, damage, or loss involving the dog or any person during training.

4. Indemnification

The Owner agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the SCVSC and CC from any claims, damages, or expenses (including legal fees) arising from the dog’s behavior during or after training.

5. Photography and video documentation

The SCVSC and CC will take photographs and video of the training for social media, Advertisement, Promotion, and future improvement. Participants are not entitled to compensation for the use.
